

force. The lien will appear on the face of the Missouri title. Titles are mailed to the vehicle owner. If you are unable to obtain the title, please call (573)751-4509 for Missouri Title. For out-of-state, contact your State Department of Revenue.

- Or a Registration Certificate or proof of ownership in accordance with the laws of the previous State or Country, only if there is a lien

- **A current insurance identification card (original or copy)**



- **Personal property tax receipt** If you are seeking to renew your vehicle tags for a two-year period, you will need to present paid tax receipts for the prior two tax years. If you need to obtain a duplicate receipt you can request it at Grandview City Hall for 1 dollar each or visit the website <http://jacksongov.org>

- A Missouri **safety inspection** not more than 60 days old by a Missouri authorized inspection station. **If your car is only 5 years-old or newer**, you only need a IDOD from a safety inspection station

You will pay:

- \$8.50 title fee; registration (license plate) fees based on either taxable horsepower or vehicle type and weight; \$2.50 title processing fee; \$3.50 for a one-year registration processing fee or \$7.00 for a two-year registration. If you registering a **new vehicle**, you will also pay state sales tax of 4.225 percent, plus your local sales tax on the net purchase amount

**Obtaining a New Driver's License - New Missouri Resident:** Out-of-State driver's license required (valid, or expired no more than 184 days). If the out-of-state license is lost/stolen/destroyed, you may instead submit a current clearance letter from that state

- **Acceptable documents for proof of Lawful Presence** - U.S. Citizen may show a birth certificate issued by a state or local government (with an embossed or raised seal), a valid or expired U.S. passport, a Certificate of Citizenship, Certificate of Naturalization, or a Certificate of Birth Abroad. For Non-U.S. Citizens, please visit <http://dor.mo.gov> for acceptable documents

- **Acceptable documents for proof of Lawful Identity** - Social Security card; for name change, Medicare card with your current name on it, certified marriage license or certified divorce decree

- **Acceptable Documents for proof of Lawful Residence** - recent utility bill (including phone, electric, gas, water, sewer, or cable), property tax receipt, or most recent bank statement, voter ID card

- Drivers 21-69 years of age receive a 6-year driver's license that expires on the applicant's date of birth on the sixth year after the date of issuance. The fee is 20 dollars

- Drivers who are 18-20 years of age receive a 3-year driver's license that expires on the applicant's date of birth in the third year after date of issuance. The fee is 10 dollars

- Drivers who are between the ages of 16-17 are issued an intermediate license that expires up to two years\* from the date issued. The fee is 7.50 dollars. For more information on requirements for Missouri Graduated Driver's License visit <http://dor.mo.gov>

- Drivers who are ages 70 and over receive a 3-year driver's license that expires on the applicant's date of birth in the third year after date of issuance. The fee is 10 dollars

## 6 Real Estate and Personal Property taxes

The County Tax Assessor's Office mails Real Estate tax statements during November of each year. The balance should be paid by December 31st. Senior citizens may be qualified for an extended payment plan. Contact the county treasurer's office at (816) 881-3232 for more details.

Many tax statements are sent to lending companies that require homeowners to maintain a property tax reserve account. If you do not receive your property tax statement, or if you know that your bank pays your taxes and you want to know the amount of your tax, contact the county treasurer's office at (816) 881-3232.

You may pay your property tax at City Hall in person or by mail. If you mail a check, be sure to include the tax parcel or account number on the check and include the tax statement's payment stub. Checks are made payable to "Jackson County Collector". Credit and Debit cards are not accepted at Grandview City Hall.


### Personal Property Tax

Personal property tax statements are also mailed during the month of November. You may pay your individual personal property tax bill at Grandview City Hall, Monday through Friday from 8 am until 5 pm. First-time auto buyers need to bring a copy of the title. If your individual personal property tax bill is incorrect, the city can make the necessary adjustments if you supply proof of the error (Copy of "Bill of Sale", a junk receipt, etc.) for the vehicle you are wanting removed. The City will need the registration or title to the replacement vehicle.

Before you can pay the current year's individual personal property tax, or make an adjustment, all previous years' taxes must be paid. If you are unable to locate your Jackson County personal property tax receipt, you may obtain a duplicate receipt at Grandview City Hall for 1 dollar each.

If you're moving in from out of the state, you'll need title or current registration and proof you lived out-of-state during the months of January and February of the previous year.

## 5 Vehicle Registration and Driver's license

**Licensing a Vehicle:** To obtain a Missouri title and registration (license plates) on a motor vehicle currently titled in another state, you must submit the following:

- An **Ownership document** such as:

- Title from the previous state or country where the vehicle was titled; if there is a lien on the vehicle, you must obtain the title from the lienholder to submit with your application. The lien will remain in
