




# covid-19 update

## confirmed cases



### city

- Directors working on departmental reopening plans due Friday.
- Finance staff is cross-training for different duties.
- Directors compiling lists of projects and trainings for off-site staff.
- Work on 1/3/6 month budget projections still in progress.
- Fire Department has transported 42 potential COVID-19 cases since mid-March.
- Fire has ample stockpile of PPE.

- Governor Parson says on Friday, May 24 he will unveil guidelines for reopening businesses,
- House negotiating nearly \$500 billion relief package for small businesses and hospitals.
- National Guard to help MO school districts hand out meals to students.
