- Jackson County revised Phase 1 of reopening plan to include opening of churches and fitness centers.
- The View is preparing staff and facility for a reopening to members on May 26. Pools and gymnasium will remain closed.
- Mayors, City Administrators working with Jackson County on Phase 2 of Reopening Plan.
- Community Development submitted grant application for money to promote public health.

regional/national/world

- Kansas announces it will not be moving to next phase of reopening, extending phase one to late June.
- KCMO prepares to reopen Saturday, May 16.
- President announces launch of plans to replenish the Strategic National Stockpile, including one billion N95 masks, 300-million by Fall.
- KC confirms first cases of COVID related inflammatory sickness in children.
