Formal presentations will be made at 4:00 p.m. and repeated at 5:30 p.m. Recordings will be available after that time. All interested persons will be given an opportunity to ask questions concerning their views on the location and design of the I-49 Frontage Road Conversion Project with reference to the economic and social effects of such location and design, its impact on the environment and its consistency with the goals and objectives of the community. The location of the presently contemplated improvement is as follows:

East and West I-49 Frontage Roads in the City of Grandview between 135th Street and Mo150 Highway in the City of Grandview

Maps, plats, environmental documentation, and other detail information prepared by the City of Grandview, will be available for public inspection and copying at the office of the Public Works Department, or from the City's Website at www.Grandview.org . Drawings will also be posted on the front door windows of the main (south) door entrance of the Grandview City Hall.

Written statements and exhibits as well as oral statements will be received at the hearing, via chat at the web meeting, or via U.S. Mail. Mailed comments will be received until the end of the day, on Friday, June 5, 2020 and should be addressed to Grandview Public Works Department, 1200 Main Street, Grandview. MO 64030. Written statements and exhibits will be made a part of the public hearing transcript if received by June 5, 2020.

Tentative schedules for right of way acquisition and construction will be discussed at the hearing. Relocation advisory assistance will be available for all persons displaced as a result of this improvement. Information on relocation assistance programs will be provided, if applicable.
