RESOLUTION NO. 2015- 13

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PURCHASING POLICY OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 2.13 "OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES".

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Policy of the City of Grandview ("City") was adopted by passage of Resolution No. 2014-03 on March 25, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance ("Director") recommended that the Purchasing Policy be amended to add a new Section 2.13 requiring City vendors to obtain an occupational license as a condition of doing business with the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Section 2.13 of the Purchasing Policy identifies categories of City vendors which are exempt from the occupational license requirement; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Section 2.13 of the Purchasing Policy complies with the legal requirements of public purchasing; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Section 2.13 of the Purchasing Policy provides reasonable assurance to the citizens of the City that the City will receive maximum value for each public dollar spent; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City wishes to amend the Purchasing Policy as recommended by the Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purchasing Policy Amended. The Purchasing Policy of the City of Grandview, Missouri, is amended, by adding a new Section 2.13 to read as follows:

2.13 OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES

- A. Chapter 13 of the Grandview Code of Laws requires certain persons and business doing business within the City to obtain an occupational license and pay an occupational license fee. Except as provided in subsection B. below, City vendors are required to obtain an occupational license as a condition of doing business with the City.
- B. City vendors falling within the following categories of business are exempt from the occupational license requirement:


1. Persons following for a livelihood the profession or calling of minister of the gospel teacher, professor in college, priest, lawyer, certified public accountant, chiropractor, optometrist, chiropodist, physician or surgeon, veterinarian, architect, professional engineer, or land surveyor.
2. Persons following for a livelihood the profession of auctioneer or real estate broker or salesman, unless that person maintains a business office within the City.
3. Farmers or producers or any person in the employ of such farmer or producer in the city selling from his, her, or their wagon, cart, or vehicle any produce raised by such farmer or producer.
4. Banks or savings and loan associations.
5. Government agencies.
6. Public utility companies.
7. Online or catalog sales if the business is not located in the City as long as the sale takes place at the vendor's place of business and the merchandise is either picked up or delivered.
8. Training or other services as long as such services take place outside the City.




