### **Grandview PD Once Again Starts Bicycle Patrols**

Add bicycles to the growing list of ways Grandview Police are working to keep the City safe and engage the people they serve and protect.

For the first time in over a decade, Grandview Police are carrying out patrols on bicycles. Five officers trained and certified through International Police Mountain Bike Association started their first pedaling patrols on Wednesday, August 31 at the newly redeveloped Truman's Marketplace. Home to stores like TJMaxx, Shoe Carnival, and Ross Dress for Less, businesses are telling officers they are especially happy to see them riding around the shopping center.

Bike patrols will be deployed as needed at Grandview shopping centers, apartment complexes, City parks and trails and special events like the upcoming Music on Main held on the revitalized and renovated Main Street. Having officers on bicycles and easily accessible to people is another way the Grandview Police Department is living up to its motto: Move Toward the Badge.
