

## Tails & Trails Dog Park Rules

- Under Missouri Law, Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and for any injuries or damages they may cause.
- Dog Park is open Sunrise to Sunset Daily. The Dog Park will be closed every Tuesday Morning from 9am-12noon for maintenance and as deemed necessary by staff.
- Dogs using the park must be licensed and meet all Dog Park health requirements.
- Dogs must stay on a leash until you reach the double gate into the off leash portion of the dog park. When exiting double gated area dogs must be on a leash.
- Dogs are not allowed into the park if they are younger than 3 months, sick, have open wounds, or routinely aggressive. Female dogs in heat are Not Permitted.
- No prong or spike or pinch collars allowed.
- Owners are required to clean up after their dogs with the bags provided, inside and outside the fenced area. Scoop the Poop!
- No other animals allowed inside the dog park fenced area.
- Female dogs in heat and dogs with fresh wounds are not allowed in the Park.
- Dogs must be under control (voice or leash) of their owners at all times.
- Any dog behaving aggressively must be immediately controlled and removed from the park.
- No more than 2 dogs per person at any one time.
- Children under 18 years old must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Spectators should remain outside the fenced dog park area.
- The park is segregated for use by small and large dogs. Small dogs are defined as dogs weighing 30lbs or less. And large dogs are defined as dogs weighing 30lbs or more. No large dogs in the small dog area; no small dogs in the large dog area.
- Smoking and eating are not allowed within the fenced dog park area.
- Dog food, long-lasting chews, and glass containers are not allowed within the fenced dog park area.
- Owners must repair holes or disturbed areas created by their dogs.
- Dog Park users must immediately leave the fenced dog park area when requested to do so by park or law enforcement personnel.
- Professional dog trainers may not use the park to conduct their business unless they have reserved an area through GVPRD .
- Bicycles, rollerblades, skates, skateboards, and strollers are prohibited within the fenced dog park area.
- All City of Grandview Ordinances apply within the Dog Park.

All Dog bites must be reported; owners should exchange contact information and call the City of Grandview Animal Control (316-4817) and GVPRD (316-4883).
