All over Grandview-- bulldozers are grading dirt, carpenters are hammering nails, and excitement is building over the businesses, homes, restaurants and new places for fun that will soon dot the Grandview landscape.

CITY PROJECTS

In 2014, Grandview voters approved a no tax-increase bond issue for Parks & Recreation and Public Safety projects. Two of the final three projects are underway right now.

SPLASH PARK: Grandview's second splash park will be attached to The View Community Center off of the pool deck (see above). City leaders and member of the Parks & Recreation Commission were happy to break ground on the new project in late March. The

new splash park will be an amenity provided in a membership to The View, or visitors can purchase a one day pass.

The Splash Park is scheduled to open late summer 2019, weather permitting for construction, of course!

SHOOTING RANGE: Located at 13200 Arrington Road inside the old Grandview Ballpark, this shooting range will be used by the Grandview Police Department for training, but will also


be open to the public as soon as the fall.

PROJECTS NEARING COMPLETION

GRAND SUMMIT: More than 400 new units are being added to the affordable luxury apartment complex on a golf course along MO HWY 150.

Easily the largest project in the City of Grandview for 2018 and 2019, contractors are currently finishing up Phase II with more than 150 new apartments.

Phase III is now underway as well. Crews have graded sites and some foundations are set. This phase will add 256 additional units.



DQ expected to open later this summer

DAIRY QUEEN/GRANDVIEW VILLAGE: In late 2018, Tutera Group got the go ahead to form a Community Improvement District at the Grandview Village on Main Street just east of White Avenue.

Developers immediately started making improvements to the shopping plaza. Crews knocked down a long-vacant oil change business to make way for a new DQ restaurant.

The interior is expected to be complete by the beginning of July. Those DQ signature red spoons should be scooping up cool soft serve just in time for hot, late summer temperatures.

The rest of the strip mall will also be getting a major facelift. Work is slated to start this summer as well.



Teague Lumber Company re-purposed Rodeway Inn for beautiful new expansion.

TEAGUE LUMBER COMPANY: The long vacant Rodeway Inn along I-49 just south of Highway 150 had slowly become an eyesore over the past decade. That is, until long-time Grandview business, Teague Lumber Company bought the property in 2018.

The company re-purposed some of the old hotel into an expansion, including offices and a specialized lumber yard. The expansion is slated to open in late 2019.



IN THE ZONE

Already home to Winco Fireworks warehousing and distribution facilities, Grandview will soon be home to its corporate offices as well.

In May 2019, Winco Fireworks announced it would build new offices in Grandview's Southpointe Business Park on Botts Road.

The fireworks wholesaler took advantage of a new federal incentives program called Opportunity Zones to purchase the property.

It's the first Opportunity Zone investment in the entire metro area and the move made headlines.

With the new building also comes 25+ employees. No word on when the project is expected to break ground.

DEVELOPMENT COMING SOON

BWISE DEVELOPMENT: This mechanical contractor is moving to Grandview from Richards-Gebauer AFB. With the new building in Southpointe Business Park comes approximately 50 employees. The project is currently slated to break ground this summer.

THE CHIVE: SIMPLY GOOD

RESTAURANT/TRANSPARENT BREWING CO.: Good things come to those who wait. Groundbreaking is expected this year for the long-awaited restaurant and brewery just off Highway 150 behind Gail's

Harley-Davidson. The five-phase project will start with construction of the brewery and a nearby modular kitchen. The hope is we'll all be able to enjoy a microbrew and some clean eats in 2020.

CS MANUFACTURING: This automotive molding manufacturer based in Michigan has made a \$5 million investment in a building near 2nd and Main and could be open for business as soon as this fall.

INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

140TH STREET BRIDGE (MoDOT): Planning is well underway as MoDOT is slated to replace one last bridge over I-49 in Grandview. On Wednesday, May 15, MoDOT held a public meeting for the 140th Street Bridge Replacement Project. Engineers and other officials were there to answer questions from citizens, as well as show plans for what the project will include, like ADA improvements, wider sidewalks and a wider bridge. The \$3.1 million MoDOT project is scheduled to begin construction in spring 2020 and finish in December of the same year.

I-49 OUTER ROAD CONVERSION (City of Grandview/MoDOT): Grandview is about to embark on one of its biggest economic development projects hinging on infrastructure. The \$15 million conversion of the I-49 Outer Roads to two-way traffic is a long-anticipated catalyst for local businesses demanding accessibility in a city divided by an interstate. The right-of-way acquisition process on the design-build project with MoDOT has already started. Public Works worked for years to secure \$11 million in grants for the project. Construction is expected to start spring of 2020.

MEDICAL MARIJUANA

In April, Missouri voters-- including 70% of Grandview voters-- approved medical marijuana allowing patients access to the drug with a prescription.

Now cities across the state are working on ordinances defining where dispensaries, cultivation and extraction facilities can be located and how far one can be located from a school, church and daycare.

Grandview City Attorney Joe Gall and City Planner Dave McCumber have been working since the approval researching, meeting and attending workshops to carefully craft a City ordinance.

"After a number of meetings and revisions, the Planning Commission passed a proposed ordinance unanimously on June 5," explains McCumber. "The hope is after a public hearing in late June, the Board of Aldermen will vote in early July."

The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) will begin accepting applications for facilities on August 3. One of the application requirements is an address of operation.

Grandview's plan is to have zoning ordinances amended prior to August 3, so that applicants will know what locations are available in the City.






