➤ NEXT STOP: GRANDVIEW *buses run every 30 minutes

On April Fool's Day, the first few buses to stop at the bus stop near Blue Ridge and Harry Truman Road won't be heading back to Kansas City-- they'll be headed into Grandview. No joke!

RideKC's 29 Blue Ridge Limited is extending service into Grandview as part of a pilot program with KCATA and the City of Grandview. This service connects Grandview to Downtown Kansas City, MO as well as other popular destinations like Cerner.

The extension will run northbound to KCMO and southbound to Grandview twice a day, Monday

through Friday in the early morning and late afternoon. Buses run every 30 minutes (see schedule above).

A \$250,000 grant made this extension possible thanks to the work of Public Works Director Dennis Randolph. The City's match for the grant is a one-time payment of \$50,000 from Grandview's Transportation Sales Tax.

"This new express route connects Grandview residents to opportunities throughout the region," said Robbie Makinen, KCATA president & CEO. "This

partnership is yet another positive move for regional transit taking place throughout our bi-state area."

The funding is expected to keep the line running over the next three years.



Changes in area Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) disposal sites forced Grandview to review its options for citizens.

In the past, Grandview residents could take their old paint, batteries, bulbs, etc. to the Lee's Summit facility for a fee, and the City of Grandview would reimburse them.

However, last year the Lee's Summit facility closed pending further notice and left Grandview residents with no HHW disposal options.

In response, Grandview joined the Regional HHW Collection Program through Mid-America Regional Council (MARC).

Grandview residents can now dispose of their HHW for free at the region's one disposal site: 4707 Deramus, Kansas City, MO.

Part of this membership also includes a mobile event where residents can bring their waste to a location right here in Grandview. That is scheduled for Saturday, August 3. Details will be released in the July newsletter, online, and on our social media channels.

Let's get real. Nobody likes the DMV, but the Grandview DMV is trying to make your life a little easier.

Now you can get in line from home, your car, or wherever you are using your smartphone, tablet, or computer!

In mid-February, the City launched the line management system, Qless.

Here's how it works: you check in at a




kiosk at the DMV, or from your device on the link www.grandview.org/qless. Once you enter your name, phone number, and tasks you need to complete (registration, titling, driver's license), Qless sends your phone a text with your anticipated wait time. You'll also get a text when your name is being called.

Your information is kept private!

The city hopes to expand this service to property taxes in the near future.


