Bids for the **2023 – 1102 Main Parking Lot** will be accepted electronically using the QuestCDN® website ([City of Grandview - Projects \(questcdn.com\)](http://City of Grandview - Projects (questcdn.com))) until 2:00 P.M. on the 10th day of *August*, 2023 Bids submitted by QuestCDN® are subject to a fee. Bids submitted after the bid acceptance deadline will not be accepted.

Description: The contract provides for 2” depth of edge milling, removal of 500 sf of existing concrete walk, removal of 530 sf of existing landscape rock and removal of 105 sy of full depth asphalt. Installation of 90 lf of concrete CG-2 curb, installation of 400 tons of 4” depth Type 5 surface asphalt, installation of 1,050 sf of 4” reinforced concrete plaza, installation of 13 concrete bumper blocks and installation of 500 lf of painted parking stall lines, painted HC logos and painted diagonal lines for non-parking zones.

This advertisement is for qualified contractors, experienced in the construction of public improvements. The successful bidder may be required to provide references concerning its experience in this type of work and proof of either ownership or lease of equipment that will be utilized to construct this project.

Contractor acknowledges that RSMo 290.210-340 establishes that a prevailing hourly wage shall be paid to workers engaged in non-maintenance public works projects valued over \$75,000.00. Contractor agrees that if the value of this project is over that threshold, contractor shall insure that not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages specified shall be paid to all workers performing under the contract. The Contractor shall forfeit as a penalty to the City \$10.00 for each worker employed for each calendar day, or portion thereof, such worker is paid less than the stipulated rates for any work done und this contractor or by any subcontractor under them. If Prevailing Wage Law applies to the project, before payments are made, an affidavit must be filed by the contractor that Contractor has fully complied with the Prevailing Wage Law. No payment can be made unless and until this affidavit is filed in proper form an order.

The project is subject to the requirements of RSMo Sec. 292.675 concerning worker safety. Pursuant to RSMo Sec 285.530 bidders are required to submit or

have on file with the City of Grandview, the Worker Eligibility Verification affidavit within the contract documents. The City of Grandview reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
